## **Agroecology Volunteer | *Natural Resources and Agroecology Department***

*Every Tuesday morning, April through October*

### **Daily Duties:**

- Weeding
- Planting and transplanting
- Harvesting fruits and vegetables

### **As Needed:**

- Preparing and packing produce for donation
- Transporting donations to partnering organizations

**No prior experience necessary; all training to be provided.**

### **Qualifications:**

- At least 18 years old
- Access to personal vehicle
- Able to meet Tuesday mornings April through October
- Physically able to...
  - Work in weather conditions ranging from hot and sunny to cool and overcast
  - Stand, sit, and kneel for extended periods of time (30+ minutes), with breaks to stretch or rest as needed
  - Walk short distances ( $\frac{1}{4}$  -  $\frac{1}{2}$  of mile) on flat to slightly uneven surfaces
  - Use tools such as weeders, trowels, pruners, rakes, and shovels
  - Carry above tools for short distances
  - Carry 5-gallon plastic buckets of material such as soil, compost, woodchips, and plant waste for short distances
  - Push wheelbarrows of material such as soil, compost, woodchips, and plant waste for short distances
- Comfortable communicating and coordinating with other volunteers and Duke Farms staff on consistent, weekly basis
