Monitor-and-Maintain Crew Member | *Multiple Departments*

Once weekly, April through October (more information available on next page)

Daily Duties:

- Weeding
- Trimming
- Invasive plant management

As Needed:

- Mulch application
- Native plant installation

No prior experience necessary. All training to be provided.

Qualifications:

- At least 18 years old
- Able to meet once per week, at specified time and location, April through October
- Physically able to...
 - Work in weather conditions ranging from hot and sunny to cool and overcast
 - Stand, sit, and kneel for extended periods of time (30+ minutes), with breaks to stretch or rest as needed
 - Walk short distances (less than ¼ of mile) on flat to slightly uneven surfaces
 - Use tools such as weeders, trowels, pruners, rakes, shovels, and loppers
 - Carry above tools for short distances
 - Carry 5-gallon plastic buckets of material such as soil, compost, woodchips, mulch, and plant waste for short distances
 - Push wheelbarrows of material such as soil, compost, woodchips, mulch, and plant waste for short distances
- Comfortable communicating and coordinating with other volunteers, crew leader(s), and Duke Farms staff on consistent, weekly basis
